Electronic Visit Verification ABN Training Invitation

Update: Additional training workshops have been added. Please see below.

Sandata Technologies has modified their Santrax system to automate the application of Advanced Beneficiary Notice (ABN) data to the electronic claims submitted to DXC Technology. This enhancement has reduced the level of effort necessary to enter ABN data for clients who have Medicare coverage. As a result, effective July 1, 2017, **Home Health service providers** who are mandated to use Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) for their Personal Care Assistant (PCA), Acquired Brain Injury (ABI), or Connecticut Home Care (CHC) waiver clients will have to enter the appropriate Medicare denial/ABN information into the Santrax system **prior** to exporting claims. Training for the new ABN feature in the Santrax system was previously conducted on June 8, 2017. Additional training dates have been provided and can be found below. Providers may register for at least one of the sessions below to learn how to use the new process.

Please Note: There is a limit of registrants to two employees per agency.

Please register as soon as possible to secure a reserved seat for the session. There are a limited number of available seats and registration is expected to fill up quickly.
