RE: 2018 HIPAA-Compliant Update to the Medical Clinical Fee Schedule

Effective for the dates of service January 1, 2018 and forward, the Department of Social Services will incorporate the 2018 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) and Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) changes (additions, deletions and description changes) to the Medical Clinic Fee Schedule. The Department is making these changes to ensure that the medical clinic fee schedule remains compliant with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). These changes apply to the HUSKY Health programs, which include HUSKY A, HUSKY B, HUSKY C and HUSKY D.

Code 90756

Effective for dates of services on or after January 1, 2018, and forward, DSS is adding code 90756 - *Influenza virus vaccine, quadrivalent (ccIV4), derived from cell cultures, subunit, antibiotic free, 0.5 ML dosage for intramuscular use*, to the 2018 Medical Clinic fee schedule. Please note, code 90756 will be added for use by enrolled medical clinics only. School-based health centers should only utilize codes that are provided through the Connecticut Vaccine Program (CVP).

Accessing the Fee Schedule:

The updated fee schedules can be accessed and downloaded by accessing the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program Web site: www.ctdssmap.com. From this Web page, go to "Provider", then to "Provider Fee Schedule

Download". Click on the "I accept" button and proceed to click on the appropriate fee schedule. To access the CSV file, press the control key while clicking the CSV link, then select "Open". An Important Message (IM) will be posted and sent to all providers once the fee schedule has been updated.
