



TO: All Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP) Providers
RE: Weather Related Transportation Cancellation / Delays

This bulletin is a reminder regarding transportation cancellation / delays due to inclement weather. Every effort will be made by the transportation provider network to continue to operate transportation services during inclement weather, however delays can be experienced and cancellations may occur due to unsafe travel conditions. In severe weather, transportation is prioritized to ensure members most at risk obtain the care they need. Prioritization of rides typically includes members who are on dialysis, undergoing radiation or chemotherapy treatments.

In an effort to prioritize care when there are weather related closures, the following policies are being considered:

Child Services:

If the Board of Education closes a school district (full day or early dismissal), Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP) enrolled providers will not transport children to after-school programs from or to the town unless it is for a critical care service.

Adult Services:

If methadone providers shift the time of medication dispensing on the day of a storm Veyo, will likewise work to rearrange transportation services on that day. If the facility plans on closing early due to weather, Veyo will cancel all trips for that day. If the methadone clinic does not open at all for business on a particular day, all trips to that clinic will be moved to the following day.

Additionally, Veyo will work with the clinic provider to determine if there is a change of time of medication dispensing on the day previous or post storm. Similarly, Veyo will work to shift transportation days and times for dialysis center closures.
