From I-95 (New Haven and points in southwest CT)

From I-95 get onto I-91 northbound in New Haven to exit 22 (route 9 southbound). Stay on route 9 through two traffic lights to exit 12, Silver Street. At the end of the exit ramp, take a left onto Silver Street. Take the next left onto Eastern Drive; the first right onto Tynan Circle; park in the parking lot and proceed to the building.

From I-95 (New London area or points in southeast CT)

From I-95 take route 9 northbound in Old Saybrook to exit 12, Bow Lane. Go straight at end of exit (cross over Bow Lane and proceed on Eastern Drive). Go straight at the next stop sign (crossing over Silver Street and remaining on Eastern Drive). Take next the right onto Tynan Circle; park in the parking lot and proceed to the building.

From I-91, (points north or south of Middletown)

Get off I-91 at exit 22 and proceed south on route 9 to exit 12.

The **southbound** exit 12 is Silver Street. At the end of the exit ramp, take a left onto Silver Street; the next left onto Eastern Drive; the first right onto Tynan Circle; park in the parking lot and proceed to the building.

The **northbound** exit 12 is Bow Lane. Go straight at the end of the exit (cross over Bow Lane and proceed on Eastern Drive). Go straight at the next stop sign (crossing over Silver Street and remaining on Eastern Drive). Take the next right onto Tynan Circle; park in the parking lot and proceed to the building.

From I-84 (New York and points west)

Take I-84 eastbound to exit 27 (691 Meriden); to I-91 northbound and follow the directions above.

From I-84 (Boston and points east)

Take I-84 westbound to Hartford; to I-91 southbound and follow those directions above.
