Attention: Outpatient Hospitals – New Version of CMAP Addendum B Updated (November 28, 2022)

An updated PDF and Excel version of the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP) Addendum B V23.3 has been approved by the Department of Social Services (DSS) and has been added to the Hospital Modernization page on the www.ctdssmap.com Web site. These changes are effective for dates of service October 1, 2022 and forward.

Payment rate changes for procedure codes assigned a status indicator G or K were updated and loaded into the system prior to October 1, 2022 effective date for dates of service October 1, 2022 and forward.

Any procedure code that is “NEW”, changed or deleted were updated on November 8, 2022.

The changes can be identified by the following indicators:

- “G or K” - A change has been made to the payment rate (status indicator G or K).
- “New” - The procedure code was added by CMS.
- “X” - A change has been made to the procedure code or status indicator.

Please note that DSS has made updates for additional Procedure Codes as follows:

- CPT code 90677 was added effective 1/1/22
- CPT codes 90611 and 90622 were added effective 10/1/22; when billing with these codes, providers must include both the procedure code for the vaccine administration with Revenue Center Code 770 “Prevent Care Svs” and the procedure code for the vaccine product with the national drug code - NDC (ages 18+)
