To: Home Health Agencies, Occupational Therapist Groups, and Individual Occupational Therapists

Update on the new services COPE and CAPABLE!

As the Department of Social Services (DSS) announced in previous Important Messages and shared at several provider forums, new evidence-based service models are being added to Medicaid-funded home and community-based services (HCBS), specifically the Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) I & II, Autism, Connecticut Home Care Program for Elders (CHCPE), and Personal Care Assistant (PCA) waiver programs.

 Training and Counseling Services for Unpaid Caregivers Supporting Participants, a.k.a. Care of Older People in their Environment (COPE) and Confident Caregiver

COPE is Drexel University's evidence-based model in which an Occupational Therapist (OT) and a Registered Nurse (RN) provide a set of supports and training to the informal caregivers of people with cognition impairment to better understand a participant's health condition and dementia. Also, the model aims to improve informal caregivers' confidence and care skills.

Confident Caregiver is designed to augment the COPE program to support family members who are providing care to persons living with serious or chronic illness without cognitive impairment.

 Participant Training and Engagement to Support Goal Attainment and Independence, a.k.a. Community Aging in Place-Advancing Better Living for Elders (CAPABLE)

CAPABLE is Johns Hopkins University's evidence-based model in which a team consisting of an OT, RN, and handy worker operate together with participants to improve both function and safety of the home environment.

Furthermore, DSS has important updates on COPE/Confident Caregiver and CAPABLE:

- 1) Rate Increase
- 2) <u>American Rescue Plan (ARP) 9817-funded training (time-limited</u> <u>opportunity)</u>

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1) <u>Rate Increase</u>

COPE/Confident Caregiver and CAPABLE's OT & RN rates are now 15% higher than the traditional Medicaid OT & RN rates.

Moreover, an additional 10% increase is approved through December 31, 2024. These rate increases aim to offset the cost of staff training time and administrative start-up time.

2) ARP 9817-funded training (time-limited opportunity)

To become a certified COPE/Confident Caregiver and/or licensed CAPABLE entity, a provider must complete self-paced online trainings offered by Drexel University and/or Johns Hopkins University. The trainings are covered under ARP funds through June 30, 2025. Afterwards, new participants will have to pay for the trainings including certificate and/or licensure fees. Do not miss this great opportunity for free training to become a COPE/Confident Caregiver and/or CAPABLE provider.
