Attention: Dentists, Dental Hygienists and Dental FQHCs

RE: Termination of Commissioner of Public Health's Order Allowing Dental Hygienists to Administer COVID-19 Vaccinations

In accordance with Special Act 22-1, the Commissioner of Public Health's authority under Conn. Gen. Stat. § 19a-131f to authorize qualified persons to administer COVID-19 vaccinations during the public health emergency expired on April 15, 2022. Effective April 16, 2022, dental hygienists are no longer permitted to administer COVID-19 vaccinations.

Claims for COVID-19 vaccinations submitted by dental hygienists will be denied. Dental Federally Qualified Health Centers must ensure that claims submitted for COVID-19 vaccinations are not administered by dental hygienists.

Other professionals authorized under the Commissioner's order <u>except for dental hygienists</u> may continue to administer COVID-19 vaccinations in accordance with declarations issued by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services under the federal Public Readiness and Emergency Preparedness Act (PREP Act).
