ICD-10 Diagnosis Codes Not Covered for Date of Services (DOS)

As of October 1, 2016, the ICD-10 (International Statistical Classification of Diseases) code sets used to report medical and behavioral diagnoses was updated and there are now ICD-10 diagnosis codes that are no longer valid. Any claim that is billed with an invalid diagnosis code will deny with Explanation of Benefit (EOB) code 4027 “Diagnosis Code Not Covered for Date of Service”. In many cases the diagnosis code requires an additional unit. Providers should refer to the American Medical Association ICD 10-CM 2017 book for a list of valid diagnosis codes for dates of service October 1, 2016 and forward.
