BCBA Licensure Requirement for Enrollment in Connecticut Medical Assistance Program

The Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) requires that all Board-Certified Behavioral Analysts (BCBAs) are licensed. Effective February 1, 2024, the Department of Social Services (DSS) will be validating licensure directly with the Connecticut Department of Public Health. All BCBAs must make sure their licensure remains current with DPH to remain enrolled with the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP).

Lack of licensure or inactive licensure will cause the provider to be disenrolled from CMAP and claims with dates of service after the disenrollment date will deny.
