Final Reminder: The deadline for PY 2019 Meaningful Use Attestations is Extended to April 30, 2020!

Due to the widespread COVID-19 outbreak, the Medicaid Promoting Interoperability (PI) Program attestation deadline has been changed to April 30, 2020. This is the last chance to attest to the Medicaid PI Program for program year 2019. Providers must submit their attestation by 11:59 pm, on April 30th, 2020. This deadline only applies to the first submission of the attestation. The provider is able to correct and re-submit the attestation after the deadline if issues are identified in the review by the Myers and Stauffer PI Program staff.

For program year 2019, eligible professionals (EPs) participating in the Medicaid PI Program (formerly the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program) must meet the reporting requirements for submitting Meaningful Use (MU) data and Clinical Quality Measures (CQMs). The reporting period for MU is 90 days and 365 days for CQMs (except for first time meaningful users).

Requirements to Participate:

- Must be one of the following provider types: Nurse Practitioners, Physicians, Dentists, Certified Nurse Midwives and Physician's Assistants from FQHCs.
- Must have 30% Medicaid patients by volume for any eligible 90 day period (20% for pediatricians).
- Must be using 2015 edition Certified EHR Technology (CEHRT).
- Must have attested to the program in a previous year.
