RE: Elimination of Co-payments for Behavioral Health Services Rendered to HUSKY B Members under the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP)

Effective for dates of service September 1, 2018 and forward, the co-payment requirement is discontinued for all behavioral health (BH) services rendered to HUSKY B members under the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP).

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As long as the billed amount on the claim is greater than the allowed amount, providers are eligible to receive the full fee schedule amount for the BH service effective for dates of service September 1, 2018 and forward. Providers must not collect the \$10.00 copayment for BH services. This change applies to BH services rendered in all outpatient settings performed by all enrolled CMAP providers for which there was previously a \$10.00 co-payment requirement for HUSKY B members.

There are no changes to the HUSKY B cost share requirements for medical and dental services. Providers must continue to collect the required cost-share for medical and dental services rendered to HUSKY B members.

This Policy Transmittal replaces and supersedes Policy Transmittal 2010-35.
