TO: Physicians, Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRN), Certified Nurse Midwives (CNM), Physician Assistants (PA) and Medical Clinics

RE: Update on Flu Vaccine Availability – Flucelvax (CPT code 90674)

Under the Connecticut Vaccine Program (CVP), Flucelvax (Seqirus), identified with National Drug Code 70461-0614-01, will be supplied by the CT Department of Public Health (CT DPH) for use with patients 4 years of age and older. Common Procedural Terminology (CPT) code 90674 can be coded when the Flucelvax (Seqirus) vaccine is administered to eligible HUSKY Health members during the 2016-2017 flu season **as part of the CVP eligibility criteria**.

The **administration** of the Flucelvax flu vaccine is eligible for reimbursement when the vaccine is administered as part of the CVP to eligible HUSKY Health members, ages 4 years to 18 years old. Consistent with current policy, the detail line submitted for the Flucelvax vaccine CPT code 90674 will deny and the administration CPT code 90460 will pay according to the Medicaid Physician Office and Outpatient fee schedule or the Medicaid Medical Clinic fee schedule.

Please note, since CPT code 90674 will not be active until January 1, 2017, the CPT code will deny if billed for non-CVP eligible patients. The Department will update all appropriate fee schedules during the annual HIPAA update for calendar year 2017 which should include CPT 90674.
