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RE: Adding Ocrelizumab to the Physician Office & Outpatient Fee Schedule

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Effective for dates of service March 1, 2020 and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS) will be adding Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) code J2350 – Ocrelizumab to the physician office and outpatient fee schedule.

Effective for dates of service March 1, 2020 and forward, the reimbursement rate is as follows:

Code	Description	Price
J2350	Ocrelizumab	\$57.42

Providers must include the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) standard 11-digit National Drug Code (NDC) on all claims when billing for physicianadministered drugs to avoid being denied or reimbursed incorrectly.

For instructions on how to format the NDC into a HIPAA standard 11-digit NDC, providers should refer to Chapter 8 on the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP) Web site, <u>www.ctdssmap.com</u>, and select the appropriate provider type from the drop down menu.
