RE: January 2026 Quarterly HIPAA Compliant Update - Independent Radiology and Physician-Radiology Fee Schedules

Effective for dates of service January 1, 2026 and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is incorporating the January 2026 Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) changes (additions, deletions and description changes) to the fee schedules for Independent Radiology and Physician-Radiology services.

DSS is making these changes to ensure that both fee schedules remain compliant with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). Providers should continue to refer to their applicable fee schedule for prior authorization and reimbursement information. The changes apply to services reimbursed under all the HUSKY Health (A, B, C, and D) programs.

Accessing the Fee Schedules:

The updated fee schedules can be accessed and downloaded from the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP) Web site: www.ctdssmap.com. From this Web page, go to "Provider", then to "Provider Fee Schedule Download". Click on the "I Accept" button and proceed to click on the appropriate fee schedule. To access the CSV file, press the control key while clicking the CSV link, then select "Open".
