The purpose of this Important Message is to provide helpful information about the transition to an Open Vendor EVV model with an aggregator solution for the collection of PCS visit data. The Open Vendor EVV model will allow providers the opportunity to use either the State's existing external EVV vendor system (i.e., Sandata Agency Management) or their own third-party ("Alternate EVV" or "ALT EVV") system to capture visit data. Please note, the transition to an Alternate EVV solution is optional. No action is required from those providers choosing to continue utilizing Sandata Agency Management.
