Announcement: MAPIR is Now Available and Accepting Medicaid Eligible Professionals (EPs) Attestations for Program Year 2020

MAPIR is now open and accepting Medicaid Promoting Interoperability Program attestations for Program Year 2020.

Requirements to Participate:

- Must be one of the following provider types: Nurse Practitioners, Physicians, Dentists, Certified Nurse Midwives and Physician's Assistants from FQHCs.
- Must have 30% Medicaid patients by volume for any eligible 90 day period (20% for pediatricians).
- Must be using 2015 edition Certified EHR Technology (CEHRT).
- Must meet the reporting requirements for submitting Meaningful Use (MU) data and Clinical Quality Measures (CQMs) over any 90 day period in 2020.
- Must have attested to the program in a previous year.

IMPORTANT: The attestation grace period for Program Year 2020 will end earlier on <u>February 28, 2021</u>, so all attestations must be received no later than this day.

In addition, please be aware that Program Year <u>2021</u> will be the last year of the Promoting Interoperability (PI) program. The Department of Social Services (DSS) will notify providers when MAPIR is available for program year 2021. All attestations must be submitted by August 31, 2021 for that program year.

To avoid any issues, please allow for enough time to submit your attestations. Do not wait until the last day to submit. There will be no extensions or exceptions for program years 2020 or 2021.
