Electronic Health Records Incentive Program: Patient Volume Common Question

This message only applies to Eligible Professionals (EP) that are attesting to the <u>Medicaid</u> EHR Incentive Program.

There are two options EPs can select for the patient volume 90-day period. EPs can select a 90-day period within the calendar year before the current program year, or they can select a 90-day period within the 12 months preceding attestation date.

In Connecticut, the attestation date is the date the provider submits their attestation in MAPIR. If the provider later makes changes to their attestation and re-submits, the resubmission date is the new attestation date. When corrections are needed in MAPIR, the attestation date will change and this may impact the EPs ability to use the same 90-day period for patient volume. This can potentially cause issues with the 90-day period selected for patient volume if the 12 months preceding attestation was used. As a result, the EP may need to change their patient volume 90-day period, and create a new Patient Encounter List (PEL) to support this new 90-day period.
