Update on the Status of Meaningful Use Public Health Measure Registry Options for the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program for Program Year 2017.

Target Audience: All Eligible Professionals and Hospitals.

The Department of Public Health and Department of Social Services recently published an updated Public Health Meaningful Use letter for Program Year 2017. Eligible Professionals (EPs) and Eligible Hospitals (EHs) now have the option to attest to either Modified Stage 2 or Stage 3 Meaningful Use.

The letter provides guidance to EPs and EHs applying to the Medicaid EHR Incentive Program in identifying which public health measures they may be required to attest to or appropriately claim exclusion.

This letter applies to anyone attesting to Meaningful Use on or after November 18, 2017.
