## RE: ICF/IID Supplemental Public Notice

May 20, 2025

Dear ICF/IID Provider,

Effective June 16 through June 30, 2025, the Connecticut Department of Social Services (DSS) will make a one-time supplemental payment to each eligible Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID) for the lifting of the direct care cap for services rendered in fiscal year 2025. The supplemental payment is based on available appropriations.

The calculation will be based on the difference in the issued fiscal year 2025 per diem rate with the direct care cap applied and the per diem with the direct care cap removed and multiplied by the total number of reported Medicaid days in the facility's 2024 annual report for the final one-time supplemental payment amount. Only facilities that were limited in their direct care caps will be eligible for the payment. The minimum per diem rate of \$501 remains in place and if the direct care cap limitation did not exceed the per diem rate of \$501, there will be no supplemental payment issued.
