RE: **Electronic Visit Verification Third Party Interface Support**

To ensure the success of the Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) implementation for providers, DSS has made a decision to support the development of all third party scheduling interfaces for providers required to implement EVV. As a result, DSS has agreed to pay the costs of the initial interface specifications with each of the designated third party interfaces. Each provider will still need to arrange for the programming specific to their third party application with their vendor and there may be resulting costs. However, all the effort in testing and QA for each third party vendor is being covered by DSS.
