RE: New Clinical Guidelines: Coverage of the OVA1® (Multivariate Index Assay) Test

OVA1® (Multivariate Index Assay) Test

OVA1®, also referred to as the multivariate index assay, was approved by the Federal Drug Administration (FDA) in 2009 as a method for identifying patients likely to have malignant or benign adnexal masses, prior to surgery. The OVA1® test incorporates the biomarker values from five immunoassays that are variably expressed in ovarian cancer, CA 125, beta 2 microglobulin, transferrin, transthyretin, and apolipoprotein A1. Proprietary software called OvaCalc combines the values for each assay and uses an algorithm to generate an ovarian malignancy risk index score.

Clinical Guidelines

The peer-reviewed medical literature does not support OVA1® testing as having the specificity necessary to define its clinical use. OVA1® testing will, therefore, be considered experimental and investigational and not medically necessary for HUSKY A, HUSKY B, HUSKY C, HUSKY D and Limited Benefit program members.
