RE: January 2025 Quarterly HIPAA Compliant Update – Clinic – Ambulatory Surgical Center Fee Schedule

Effective for dates of service January 1, 2025 and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is incorporating the January 2025 Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) changes (additions, deletions, and description changes) to the Clinic-Ambulatory Surgical Center (ASC) fee schedule. DSS is making these changes to ensure that the ASC fee schedule remains compliant with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

Providers should continue to refer to the ASC fee schedule for reimbursement information. This update applies to services reimbursed under the HUSKY Health programs (A, B, C, and D).

## **Accessing the Fee Schedule:**

The updated Clinic-Ambulatory Surgical Center fee schedule can be accessed and downloaded by going to the Connecticut Medical Assistance (CMAP) Web site: <a href="https://www.ctdssmap.com">www.ctdssmap.com</a>. From this Web page, go to "Provider", then to "Provider Fee Schedule Download", read the end user license agreements, scroll to the bottom of the page, click on "I Accept", and then to the "Clinic-Ambulatory Surgical Center" fee schedule. To access the CSV file, press the control key while clicking the CSV link, then select "Open".
