TO: Physicians, Physician Assistants, Advanced Practice Registered Nurses, Certified Nurse Midwives and General Hospitals

RE: Additional Guidance Regarding Shared/Split Medical Visits

Effective for dates of service retroactive to January 1, 2021 and forward, joint/split patient encounters between *non-physician practitioner (NPP's) and supervising physicians, time spent assessing and managing the patient (distinct face to face and non-face to face time) can be added together for assessing and managing a patient when determining the level of service.

*NPPs are defined as physician assistants (PA), advanced practice registered nurses (APRN) and certified nurse midwives (CNM).

The Department of Social Services (DSS) is following the guidance as published in the 2021 Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) manual published by the American Medical Association (AMA) regarding split/shared medical visits.

Please Note: Only distinct time should be summed for shared/split medical visits. When two or more individuals jointly meet with or discuss the patient, only the time of one individual should be counted.
