TO: Independent Laboratories, Physicians, and General Hospitals

RE: 2021 Revision of Rates for Certain Clinical Diagnostic Laboratory Testing Codes

Effective for dates of service retroactive to January 1, 2021 and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is adjusting the reimbursement for the following clinical diagnostic laboratory services:

This update is being made to comply with federal Medicaid law (42 U.S.C. § 1396b(i)(7)), which prohibits state Medicaid programs from paying more than Medicare would pay for any laboratory service. These changes apply to the HUSKY Health Programs A, B, C and D.

Please note: Claims billed with dates of service January 1, 2021 and forward will be automatically reprocessed and reimbursed up to the billed amount or new reimbursement rate, whichever is lower, in the March 26, 2021 claim cycle.
