RE: Remote Early Intervention Services

Effective July 1, 2021, the Department of Social Services (DSS) amends *Provider Bulletin (PB) 2020-16* “Remote Early Intervention Treatment Services” and *PB 2020-17* “*CMAP COVID-19 Response – Bulletin 6 – Emergency Remote Early Intervention Services*” as follows: Birth to Three Providers must follow the latest Office of Early Childhood (OEC) remote early intervention procedures authorized and in effect for the applicable dates of service (including, if applicable, any interim procedures for COVID-19, to the extent such procedures are in effect), as posted on the Lead Agency Birth to Three website at: <https://www.birth23.org/providers/provider-resources/procedures>.

The OEC procedures that were attached to PB 2020-16 and 2020-17 may not be current and providers must consult the Lead Agency Birth to Three website above to obtain the current procedure(s) for the applicable dates of service. In all other respects, the above-referenced bulletins remain in effect.
