RE: Family Planning Clinic Fee Schedule - October 2021 Quarterly HIPAA Compliant Update

The Department of Social Services (DSS) will incorporate the October 2021 quarterly Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) changes (procedure code additions, deletions and description changes) to the Clinic – Family Planning fee schedule. DSS is making these changes to ensure that the Clinic – Family Planning fee schedule remains compliant with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). These changes apply to the HUSKY Health programs (HUSKY A, B, C and D) and the Family Planning Limited Benefit.

Effective for dates of service October 1, 2021 and forward, procedure code J7303 is being discontinued and replaced with the following procedure codes:

- **J7294** - Segesterone acetate and ethinyl estradiol 0.15mg, 0.013mg per 24 hours; yearly vaginal system, each
- **J7295** - Ethinyl estradiol and etonogestrel 0.015mg, 0.12mg per 24 hours; monthly vaginal ring, each

The above procedure codes will be reimbursed at 100% of the current 340-B pricing with an added dispensing fee of \$10.75.

Accessing the Fee Schedule:

The updated fee schedule can be accessed and downloaded from the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP) Web site: www.ctdssmap.com. From this Web page, go to "Provider", then to "Provider Fee Schedule Download". Click on the "I accept" button and proceed to click on the Clinic - Family Planning / Abortion fee schedule. To access

the CSV file, press the control key while clicking the CSV link, then select "Open".
