RE: Updated Billing Instructions for Sevenfact

Pharmacy providers were instructed to bill claims for Sevenfact (coagulation factor VIIa recombinant-jncw) National Drug Code (NDC) 71127-1000-01 or 71127-5000-01 with the units billed in vials in [PB 20-76](#).

First DataBank (FDB) received price corrections from the manufacturer. As a result, pricing of these NDCs has changed from vial to microgram, consistent with the National Council for Prescription Drug Programs (NCPDP) Billing Unit Standard policy for antihemophilic factors.

Effective immediately, providers must submit claims for Sevenfact with the units billed in micrograms.

The claims will continue to be priced by taking the actual acquisition cost from the submitted manufacturer's invoice plus an 8% markup plus a \$10.75 dispensing fee. Please note, antihemophilic factors, with the exception of Hemlibra, continue to be billed so that each unit is billed as an "Each" in Field 12 (Quantity Dispensed) of the NCPDP Universal Pharmacy paper claim form. As a reminder, during the Temporary Effective Period, electronic claim submission of coagulation factor drugs will be required until the Department of Social Services (DSS) has notified providers in writing that the state has deemed COVID-19 to no longer be a public health emergency.
