RE: Reinstating Enhanced Care Clinic (ECC) Access Requirements that were Temporarily Suspended during the Federal COVID-19 Public Health Emergency

Effective for dates of service on and after May 12, 2023, which is the first day after the end of COVID-19 federal public the health emergency, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is reinstating the Enhanced Care Clinics (ECCs) access standards as outlined in PB 2018-22, Access Requirements Freestanding Behavioral Health Enhanced Care Clinics under the Connecticut Behavioral Health Partnership. ECCs should continue to refer to PB 2018-22 for all access requirements.

This provider bulletin supersedes guidance issued under PB 2020-19— CMAP COVID-19 Response – Bulletin 7: Enhanced Care Clinic (ECC) Access Requirements which suspended ECCs access requirements in response to the Governor's declaration of the public health emergency due to the outbreak of COVID-19 (coronavirus).

Effective for dates of service May 12, 2023, and forward, the following requirements will be reinstated:

- ECCs will resume general access requirements regarding screening and triaging all referrals, whether telephonic or walk-in and evaluating a member within the required timeframes for emergent, urgent and routine evaluations. Expectations regarding an emergent, urgent, or routine follow-up visit shall also be reinstated.
- ECC performance related to the access requirement will be monitored through periodic compliance surveys, including but not limited to Mystery Shopper calls.

• ECCs will resume extended hours of operations except for exempted secondary sites; the temporary merging of sites will no longer be permitted.
