TO: All Dentists, Dental Clinics and Federally Qualified Health Centers

RE: Changes to the Dental Fee Schedule

Effective for dates of service April 1, 2023, and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS), is adjusting the dental fee schedule in recognition that the Public Health Emergency (PHE) is scheduled to end on May 11, 2023.

During the PHE, Current Dental Terminology (CDT) code, D0190 "Screening of a Patient" was used for teledentistry visits [see PB20–21 CMAP COVID-19 Response- Bulletin 14: Emergency Temporary Telehealth Coverage for Specified Dental Services for reference]. As of April 1, 2023, and forward, the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP) will no longer cover this code.

All dental providers are strongly encouraged to verify each Member's eligibility before proceeding with dental care.
