RE: October 2023 Quarterly HIPAA Compliant Update - Physician Office and Outpatient and Clinic and Outpatient Hospital Behavioral Health

Quarterly HIPAA Compliant Update:

Effective for dates of service October 1, 2023, and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is incorporating the October 2023 Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) changes (additions, deletions, and description changes) to the physician office and outpatient and the clinic and outpatient hospital behavioral health fee schedules.

DSS is making these changes to ensure that the applicable fee schedules remain compliant with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). The changes apply to services reimbursed under the HUSKY Health programs (A, B, C, and D).

Adding Billing Codes for Respiratory Syncytial Virus Vaccines:

Effective for dates of service October 1, 2023, and forward, the following procedure codes will be added to the physician office & outpatient fee schedule:

| Procedure Code | Description | Rate |
|----------------|---|------|
| 90380 | Respiratory syncytial virus, monoclonal antibody 0.5 mL dosage, for intramuscular use | MP |
| 90381 | Respiratory syncytial virus, monoclonal antibody, 1 mL dosage, for intramuscular use | MP |

This change applies to services reimbursed under HUSKY Health (HUSKY A, B, C, and D).
