RE: January 2024 HIPAA Compliant Updates for MEDS

Effective for dates of service January 1, 2024 and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is incorporating the January 2024 Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) changes (additions, deletions and description changes) to the Durable Medical Equipment (DME); Orthotics and Prosthetics (O & P); Parenteral/Enteral Supplies and Medical Surgical Supplies (MSS) fee schedules.

DSS is making these changes to ensure that the DME, O & P, Parenteral/Enteral Supplies and MSS fee schedules remain compliant with the Health and Insurance Portability Accountability Act (HIPAA). Providers should continue to refer to the fee schedule for prior authorization. quantities. and reimbursement information. The changes apply to services reimbursed under the HUSKY Health (A, B, C and D) programs.

Accessing the Fee Schedules:

The updated fee schedules can be accessed and downloaded from the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program Web site: <u>www.ctdssmap.com</u>. From this Web page, go to "Provider", then to "Provider Fee Schedule Download". Click on the "I accept" button and proceed to click on the appropriate fee schedule.
