2. Adding New Moderna COVID-19 Vaccine

1. April 2026 Quarterly HIPAA Compliant Update:

Effective for dates of service April 1, 2026 and forward, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is incorporating the April 2026 Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) changes (additions, deletions and description changes) to the physician office and outpatient fee schedule.

DSS is making these changes to ensure that the physician office and outpatient fee schedule remains compliant with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). The changes apply to services reimbursed under the HUSKY Health programs (A, B, C, and D).

Addition of the Moderna Vaccine:

Effective April 1, 2026, CPT code 91323-Moderna vaccine for COVID-19 will be added the physician office and outpatient fee schedule.

Code Addition	Description	Rate
91323	Sarscov2 vac 10 mcg/0.2ml IM (Moderna)	\$201.91

This vaccine is FDA approved for individuals classified as “high risk” for severe outcomes from COVID-19 or for individuals 65 years of age and older. Based on this approval, claims submitted for CPT code 91323 will be eligible

for reimbursement for HUSKY Health members ages 19 and older. Providers should continue to refer to provider bulletin, [PB 24-52](#) Updated COVID-19 Vaccine Administration Guidance and Reimbursement for additional guidance on the reimbursement for the administration of COVID-19 vaccines.

As a reminder, there are specific COVID-19 vaccines available through the CT Vaccine Program (CVP) for use in all children ages 6 months through 18 years. Consistent with HUSKY Health policy, the applicable pediatric vaccines must be acquired through the CVP and DSS will only reimburse for the administration of these vaccines for this age group and will deny reimbursement for the product procedure code. The changes apply to services reimbursed under the HUSKY Health programs (A, B, C, and D).
