RE: Updates to the Chiropractor Fee Schedule

Effective on July 1, 2026, procedure code 98943 - chiropractic manipulative treatment to regions other than spine, will no longer be eligible for reimbursement under the Connecticut Medical Assistance Program (CMAP).

The Department of Social Services (DSS) is end-dating procedure code 98943, to ensure compliance with federal and state law including Sections 17b-262-535 - 17b-262-545 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Sections and 42 CFR 440.60 which specify Medicaid coverage for chiropractor services as manual manipulation of the spine.

This provider bulletin (PB) supersedes, when appropriate and otherwise supplements the guidance found in "[PB 21-65 Medicaid Coverage of Chiropractic Services](#)" and "[PB 24-46 Medicaid Coverage of Evaluation/Management Visits Performed by Chiropractors](#)".
