

## Pharmacy DUR Reason for Service, Professional Service and Result of Service Codes

Below is a list of NCPDP version 5.1 Reason for Service Codes that providers may receive as well as the list of Professional Service Codes and Result of Service Codes.

<b>Reason For Service Code</b>	<b>Professional Service Code</b>	<b>Result of Service Code</b>
ER = Over Use	M0 = Prescriber Consulted	1A= Filled as is, false positive
TD = Therapeutic Duplication	P0 = Patient Consulted	1B = Filled prescription as is
DD= Drug-Drug Interaction	R0 = Pharmacist Consulted Other Source	1C = Filled with different dose
HD = High Dose		1D = Filled with different directions
PG = Pregnancy		1E = Filled with different drug
LR = Under Use		1F = Filled with different quantity
PA = Drug/Age		1G = Filled with prescriber approval
LD = Low Dose		2A = Prescription not filled
		2B = Not filled, direction clarified

Result of Service Codes 1A through 1G are used to override alerts.

Result of Service Codes 2A and 2B are used to cancel the previously submitted claim.

Please note that the values in the Professional Service Codes are zeros (0), and not the letter O. Overrides submitted with the letter O will cause claim denials.
